AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 521.16, SUBSECTION (d) OF THE MUNROE FALLS CODIFIED ORDINANCES TO ADDRESS NOTICE OF SERVICE OF VIOLATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City currently has legislation to address unlicensed vehicles; and

WHEREAS, said legislation is intended to assist in maintaining a safe environment within the community; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to streamline the notice provision under said Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MUNROE FALLS, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

Section 1. Munroe Falls Codified Ordinance, Section 521.16, subsection (d), is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

521.16 STORAGE OF BUILDING MATERIALS, UNLICENSED VEHICLES, ETC.

(d) In the event of a violation of this section, the Chief of Police shall cause notice to be given to the owner, occupant, or other person having charge of the premises upon which the violation occurs, to cease such violation within ten days of receipt of such notice.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.00 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Munroe Falls and further to provide for maintaining a safe environment in the community by addressing unlicensed vehicles and provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in full force from and immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
