AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1305.01 OF THE MUNROE FALLS CODIFIED ORDINANCES TO UPDATE THE CITY OF MUNROE FALLS NATIONAL ELECTRIC CODE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City has adopted Chapter 13, entitled "Ohio Building Code"; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to update the applicable codes for purposes of enforcement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MUNROE FALLS, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

Section 1. Chapter 13, Section 1305.01 entitled "Adoption", is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Under provisions of Ohio Revised Code 731.231, the City adopts, for purposes of regulating and safeguarding the use of electricity, electric installations and materials, those codes known as the National Electric Code, as amended from time-to-time and recommended by the National Fire Protection Association and the Tri-County Minimum Residential Rewire Electric Code, as amended from time-to-time by the Tri-County National Electric Code Uniform Interpretation Committee, with the intentions that the National Electric Code will be applied in its then current version at any time an issue is brought before the City."

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.00 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Munroe Falls and further to immediately update the City of Munroe Falls' National Electric Code and provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in full force from and immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
