AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 161, SECTION 161.02(a) ENTITLED "PAID HOLIDAYS" OF THE MUNROE FALLS CODIFIED ORDINANCES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City desires to amend the "Paid Holidays" schedule for all full-time, non-bargaining unit employees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MUNROE FALLS, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

<u>Section 1.</u> Section 161.02 entitled "Fringe Benefits", specifically Subsection (a), is amended to read as follows:

"Paid Holidays". All full-time, non-bargaining unit employees shall be entitled to eight (8) paid designated holidays, as follows: the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January, the last Monday in May, the 4<sup>th</sup> day in July, the 1<sup>st</sup> Monday in September, the 4<sup>th</sup> Thursday in November, the Friday following the 4<sup>th</sup> Thursday in November, the 24<sup>th</sup> day in December, and the 25<sup>th</sup> day in December. Additionally, all full-time, non-bargaining unit employees shall be entitled to four (4) floating holidays during each calendar year, to be scheduled with the appropriate supervisor."

<u>Section 2.</u> It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.00 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 3.</u> This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Munroe Falls and further to allow for the employees exercise their paid holidays, retroactive to January 1, 2014, and provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in full force from and immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
