AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 711.02 ENTITLED "ALARM USERS PERMIT", SECTIONS (e) and (f), TO ALLOW FOR THE CONSOLIDATION OF ALL PERMIT FEES IN CHAPTER 163 OF THE MUNROE FALLS CODIFIED ORDINANCES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City desires to consolidate all reference to City fees in Chapter 163 of the Munroe Falls Codified Ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MUNROE FALLS, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO THAT:

Section 1. Section 711.02(e) is amended in its entirety to read as follows:

"A re-issued user's permit shall be obtained from the Chief of Police by updating the original application containing the information as provided in subsection (b) hereof and paying the fee set forth in Section 163.33 of the Munroe Falls Codified Ordinances.

Each permit shall bear the same expiration date as the date on the user's original permit. The permit shall be physically upon the premises, which is using the alarm system, and shall be available for inspection by the Munroe Falls Police Department."

- Section 711.02(f) is amended in its entirety to read as follows:

"The fee established in Section 163.33(d) of the Munroe Falls Codified Ordinances will be charged to an alarm user who is more than 30 days delinquent in renewing a permit."


Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.00 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Munroe Falls and further to provide for the immediate implementation of the consolidation of all fees in Chapter 163 and provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in full force from and immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
