AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE APPOINTMENT BY THE MAYOR OF DAVID BAILEY AS INTERIM DIRECTOR OF FINANCE/CLERK OF COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF MUNROE FALLS AND CONFIRMING THE COMPENSATION FOR SUCH APPOINTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Mayor has appointed David Bailey to serve as the Interim Director of Finance/Clerk of Council, subject to bond approval, for the City of Munroe Falls; and

WHEREAS, the City Charter requires confirmation of said action by the Council of the City of Munroe Falls; and

WHEREAS, the Council is required to establish the compensation of the Director of Finance/Clerk of Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MUNROE FALLS, COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Financial services as provided in City Charter Section 7.03 shall be provided to this City and David Bailey shall be the person employed to provide such services and shall be known as the "Interim Director of Finance" for the City of Munroe Falls. Such person shall be employed as Interim Director of Finance for a period commencing on February 22, 2016 and continuing until not later than June 30, 2016.

<u>Section 2.</u> The Interim Director of Finance shall be hired at the rate of \$2,100.00 per pay, payable bi-weekly, for services to include those specified in Article VII, Section 7.03 of the Charter of the City of Munroe Falls.

Section 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and all deliberations of this Council, and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, safety and welfare of the City of Munroe Falls, and provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to Council, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and
