**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE APPOINTMENT BY THE MAYOR OF JERRY W. HUGHES AS CHIEF OF POLICE FOR THE CITY OF MUNROE FALLS AND CONFIRMING THE COMPENSATION FOR SUCH APPOINTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor has appointed Jerry W. Hughes, a certified police officer who has had prior supervisory police experience, to serve as the Chief of Police for the City of Munroe Falls; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Charter requires confirmation of said action by the Council of the City of Munroe Falls; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council is required to establish the annual compensation of the Chief of Police.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MUNROE FALLS, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO; THAT:**

**Section 1:** The appointment of Jerry W. Hughes as the Chief of Police of the City of Munroe Falls is hereby confirmed in accordance with Section 9.03 of the Charter of the City, for a period commencing on April 2, 2016, and continuing until his death, resignation, or removal by the Mayor.

**Section 2:** The Chief of Police shall be hired at the rate of \$67,320.00 per year, payable bi-weekly, for services to include those specified in Article IX, Section 9.03 of the Charter and Section 151.03 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Munroe Falls.

**Section 3:** The Chief of Police shall be given 80 hours of vacation time, effective as of April 2, 2016, as permitted in City Ordinance No.: 2012-01, dated February 21, 2012.

**Section 4:** The Chief of Police shall accrue in the first year, beginning on April 2, 2016, 3.08 hours of vacation time per pay period through April 1, 2017; and 6.15 hours per pay period, beginning on April 2, 2017.


**Section 5:** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


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
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**Section 6:** This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of the residents of the City of Munroe Falls and for the further reason that his Ordinance is required to be immediately effective so that the Chief of Police services can remain continuous, and provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to Council, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowable by law.
