AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE APPOINTMENT BY THE MAYOR OF KAREN REYNOLDS AS DIRECTOR OF FINANCE/CLERK OF COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF MUNROE FALLS AND CONFIRMING THE COMPENSATION FOR SUCH APPOINTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Mayor has appointed Karen Reynolds, to serve as the Director of Finance/Clerk of Council, subject to bond approval, for the City of Munroe Falls; and

WHEREAS, the City Charter requires confirmation of said action by the Council of the City of Munroe Falls; and

WHEREAS, the Council is required to establish the annual compensation of the Director of Finance/Clerk of Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MUNROE FALLS, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO; THAT:

Section 1: Financial services as provided in City Charter Section 7.03 shall be provided to this City and Karen Reynolds shall be the person employed to provide such services and shall be known as the "Director of Finance/Clerk of Council" for the City of Munroe Falls. Upon completion of a pre-employment drug screening, such person shall be employed as Director of Finance for a period commencing on May 16, 2016 and continuing until her death, resignation, or removal by the Mayor.

Section 2: The Director of Finance shall be hired at the rate of \$67,000.00 per year, payable bi-weekly, for services to include those specified in Article VII, Section 7.03 of the Charter of the City of Munroe Falls.

Section 3: The Direction of Finance shall be given 80 hours of vacation time, effective as of May 16, 2016, as allowed for in Ordinance 01-2012, dated 2/21/12.

Section 4: The Director of Finance shall accrue in the first year, beginning on May 16, 2016, 3.08 hours of vacation time per pay period through May 15, 2017; and 6.15 hours per pay period, beginning on May 16, 2017.


Section 5: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

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
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
Section 6: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of the residents of the City of Munroe Falls and for the further reason that this Ordinance is required to be immediately effective to provide a prompt resolution to City affairs, and further so that the Finance Director/Clerk of Council services can remain continuous, and provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to Council, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowable by law.
