AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE MUNROE FALLS VOLUNTEER PEACE OFFICERS' DEPENDENTS FUND BOARD, NOMINATING AND ELECTING TWO MEMBERS OF COUNCIL TO SERVE AS BOARD MEMBERS FOR THE 2016 YEAR, AND AUTHORIZING THE PAYMENT OF ANY AND ALL PREMIUMS AND BASIC CAPITAL CONTRIBUTIONS AS REQUIRED BY THE OHIO REVISED CODE.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio Legislature, enacted Senate Bill II establishing the Volunteer Peace Officers' Dependents Fund ("VPODF") to provide death benefits to survivors of volunteer peace officers killed in the line of duty and disability benefits to disabled volunteer peace officers as set forth in Chapter 143 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, the City of Munroe Falls is required to establish its own Volunteer Peace Officers' Dependents Fund Board to administer benefits to qualifying City of Munroe Falls volunteer reserve police officers in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Chapter 143.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MUNROE FALLS, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO; THAT:

Section 1: City Council approves the establishment of a Voluntary Peace Officers' Dependents Fund Board to administer benefits to qualifying City of Munroe Falls volunteer reserve police officers injured or killed in the line of duty. The Board shall be composed of five (5) members elected pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Chapter 143 and any subsequent amendments thereto. The Board shall organize and conduct all business in the manner prescribed by Ohio Revised Code Chapter 143. The Board shall at all times be considered a Public Body subject to all applicable Codified Ordinances of the City of Munroe Falls regarding meeting procedures and notice requirements that are otherwise not in conflict with the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 2: In accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 143.02 (A)(1), City Council hereby nominates and elects the following two (2) members of council to serve on the Volunteer Peace Officers' Dependents Fund Board for the 2016 year:

1. Jim Iona
2. Chris Ritzinger

Section 3: The Finance Director is hereby authorized to appropriate, encumber, and pay funds toward all premiums and basic capital contributions owed to the VPODF for 2016 and each year thereafter as determined and required by Ohio Revised Code Sections 14306 and 143.07.




