AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING YEARLY PAID HOLIDAYS FOR NON-BARGAINING EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF MUNROE FALLS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, certain bargaining unit employees of the City of Munroe Falls have entered into agreements with the City regarding holidays; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to establish a yearly holiday calendar for its non-bargaining employees which shall be commensurate to that for its bargaining unit employees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MUNROE FALLS, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. The City hereby establishes that its non-bargaining employees shall be entitled to the following twelve (12) paid holidays:

1. New Year's Day
2. Martin Luther King Day
3. Presidents' Day
4. Memorial Day
5. Independence Day
6. Labor Day
7. Columbus Day
8. Veterans Day
9. Thanksgiving Day
10. Day after Thanksgiving
11. Christmas Eve
12. Christmas Day

Section 2. In the event that any of the above twelve (12) holidays falls on a weekend, the City shall recognize the Friday before or the Monday after as the designated holiday.

Section 3. The Munroe Falls City Hall will be closed on the days that the above holidays are observed.


Section 4: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and all deliberations of this Council, and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

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Section 5: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of the residents of the City of Munroe Falls, and for the further reason that this Ordinance is required to be immediately effective so that the management of the City of Munroe Falls and the scheduling of its employees can remain continuous, and provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to Council, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowable by law.
