AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 163.23, SIDEWALK FEES, OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MUNROE FALLS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Munroe Falls enacted Section 163.23 of the Munroe Falls Codified Ordinances to establish and codify fees for a sidewalk repair program for the benefit of all Munroe Falls residents at a public meeting held on September 19, 2006; and

WHEREAS, the Codified Ordinances of the City of Munroe Falls authorize the City to require abutting property owners to make sidewalk repairs at the abutting property owner's expense; and

WHEREAS, due to the City's current financial situation, the City desires to terminate the sidewalk repair program and to eliminate the sidewalk fees set forth in Section 163.23 of the Munroe Falls Codified Ordinances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MUNROE FALLS, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO; THAT:

Section 1. Section 163.23, entitled "Sidewalk Fees," is hereby repealed with Section 163.23 remaining "reserved."

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council, and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of the residents of the City of Munroe Falls and for the further reason that this Ordinance is required to be immediately effective to eliminate the fees associated with the sidewalk repair program and provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to Council, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowable by law.
