AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 105.01, BIDDING REQUIREMENTS, SUBSECTION (a)(2) OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MUNROE FALLS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Section 105.01(a)(2) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Munroe Falls currently permits the Mayor to enter into a contract to purchase supplies, materials, services, insurance, and/or labor involving not more than fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000.00) during a calendar year without written approval from Council or the necessity of competitive bidding; and

WHEREAS, it is in the fiscal interest of the City and therefore of benefit to the residents and taxpayers to provide for an adjustment in the threshold amount authorized to be contracted for prior to written Council approval or competitive bidding; and

WHEREAS, this Council believes it is necessary to amend Section 105.01, Bidding Requirements, Subsection (a)(2) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Munroe Falls.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MUNROE FALLS, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Council hereby amends Section 105.01(a)(2), Bidding Requirements, of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Munroe Falls to read as follows:

105.01 BIDDING REQUIREMENTS

(a)(2) The Mayor may enter into a contract to purchase supplies, materials, services, insurance, and/or labor involving not more than twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00) during a calendar year without written approval from Council or the necessity of competitive bidding.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and all deliberations of this Council, and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of the residents of the City of Munroe Falls, and for the further reason that this Ordinance is required to permit the immediate fiscal benefit of the City, and provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to Council, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowable by law.


