AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 181.081 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MUNROE FALLS TO INCREASE THE CREDIT FOR TAX PAID TO ANOTHER MUNICIPALITY FROM TWO PERCENT (2%) TO TWO AND ONE-QUARTER PERCENT (2.25%), EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2018, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, this Council previously adopted Ordinance No. 2017-03 which amended Section 181.012 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Munroe Falls to increase the municipal income tax rate one-quarter percent (0.25%) from two percent (2.0%) to two and one-quarter percent (2.25%), effective January 1, 2018, subject to the approval of the electors of the City; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Munroe Falls approved the increase of the municipal income tax rate of the City from two percent (2.0%) to two and one-quarter percent (2.25%), effective January 1, 2018, at the general election held on May 2, 2017; and

WHEREAS, this Council has determined to amend Section 181.081 of the Codified Ordinances of the City to increase the credit for tax paid to another municipality one-quarter percent (0.25%) from two percent (2.0%) to two and one quarter percent (2.25%) , effective January 1, 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MUNROE FALLS, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. This Council has determined that it is necessary to increase the credit for tax paid to another municipality one-quarter percent (0.25%) from two percent (2.0%) to two and one-quarter percent (2.25%), effective January 1, 2018.

Section 2. Section 181.081 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Munroe Falls is hereby amended and restated in its entirety, effective January 1, 2018, to read as follows:

“181.081 CREDIT FOR TAX PAID TO ANOTHER MUNICIPALITY

The credit provided for tax paid to another municipal corporation for work or services performed in the other municipal corporation shall not exceed two and one-quarter percent (2.25%).”

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and all deliberations of this Council, and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.





Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, safety, and welfare of the residents of the City of Munroe Falls, and for the further reason that this Ordinance is required to be immediately effective in order to replace lost revenue and to secure the City's financial future, and provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected to Council, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowable by law.
